School PDG Statement

The Pupil Deprivation Grant (PDG) is allocated to schools with pupils who come from lowincome families and are currently known to be eligible for free school meals (e-FSM) and pupils who have been looked after continuously for more than six months (LAC). Schools are expected to make the best use of this funding to implement sustainable strategies that will quickly bring about changes for learners eligible for free school meals or who are LAC. As a school we have agreed the following three steps:

- 1. to identify the target group of pupils, its characteristics, and needs
- 2. to plan interventions which make the most effective use of resources
- 3. to monitor and evaluate the impact of resources

In 2023 -2024, Ysgol Yr Hendy was provided with a PDG allocation of £39,100

This includes : eFSM £31,050 EY £8,050

At Ysgol Yr Hendy we have a comprehensive plan, agreed and monitored by Carmarthenshire Local Authority, to promote progress and remove barriers to learning for students eligible for this funding. We have used the funding available to:

- Identify pupils who would benefit from proven and effective catch up groups in Literacy and Mathematics.
- Provide intervention and support programmes that are proven to have the greatest impact and to be sustainable literacy, numeracy and well-being.
- Implement and use data tracking systems to identify learners' needs, target interventions and monitor impact.
- Support pupils to access trips to have further life experiences.
- · Develop children's sport skills with a weekly Football coaching sessions.
- · Encourage creativity, with a local artist.
- Purchase PASS survey Pupil Attitudes to Self and School. A Nationally recognised robust self evaluation system for the standardised measurement of pupil attitudes.
- Improve attendance figures in line with County targets.
- Work in partnership with other schools, the community and other organisations TAF in school, the poverty
